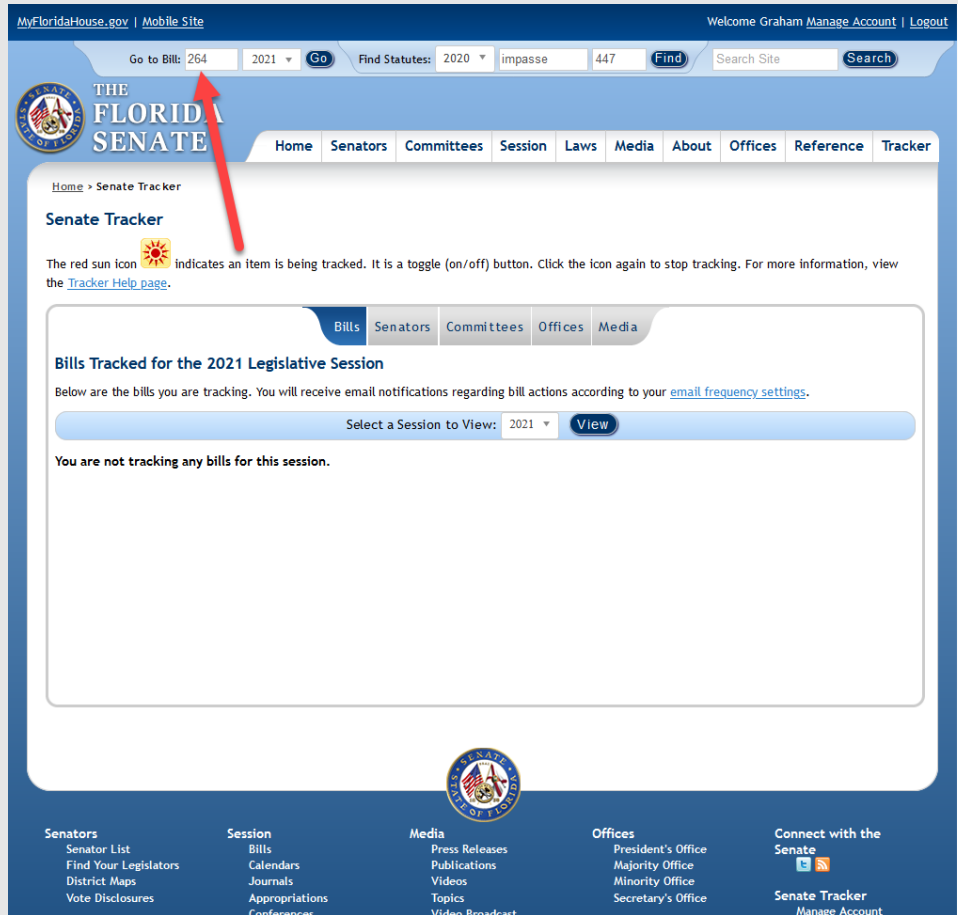

SB 264: Higher Education

GENERAL BILL by [Rodriguez](#)

Higher Education; Requiring the State Board of Education to require each Florida College System institution to conduct an annual assessment related to intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity at that institution; prohibiting the State Board of Education from shielding Florida College System institution students from certain speech; requiring the Board of Governors to require each state university to conduct an annual assessment related to intellectual freedom and viewpoint diversity at that institution; prohibiting the Board of Governors from shielding state university students from certain speech, etc.
